

Garden Care Guide

Thank you for purchasing a plant for your garden from DJA Plants. Your plant was grown from seed, cutting or division in our greenhouse in Cheshire. With the correct care it will grow with you and be a part of your garden for many years to come.

Coir pots – We chose to use coir pots for our garden plants as they are made from the unused fibres of coconut husks. They are made in Sri Lanka and arrive in the UK on scheduled ships. They fully biodegrade when you plant them adding organic matter back into your soil meaning you have no waste to dispose of

Before planting – It is vital that before planting you ensure that the soil is thoroughly wet inside your coir pot. We recommend soaking the pot in water for minimum of 1 hour before planting into the soil. If the soil is dry prior to planting it will be incredibly difficult to wet once planted and could result in the plant dying. Remember to water regularly whilst the plant establishes itself into the soil.

Care in the pot – These coir pots can dry out quite quickly on a hot day and can be difficult to get wet again if you only water from above. If you pick up your plant and it feels really light then I recommend sitting in water for an hour. Always check the weight of the pot when watering as this is your indicator to how much water the plant has available to its roots.
